Enrollment in *BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)* depends on contract renewal. *BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)* is a voluntary MassHealth (Medicaid) program in association with Executive Office of Health and Human Services and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services. Boston Medical Center HealthNet Plan is a health plan that contracts with both Medicare and MassHealth (Medicaid) to provide benefits of both programs to enrollees. It is for people with MassHealth (Medicaid) and Medicare age 65 and older.
- ❖ Under *BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)* you can get your Medicare and MassHealth (Medicaid) services in one health plan called a Senior Care Options plan. A *BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)* care manager will help manage your health care needs.

<b>What is a Senior Care Options Plan?</b>	A Senior Care Options Plan is a health plan that contracts with both Medicare and MassHealth (Medicaid) to provide benefits of both programs to enrollees. It is for people age 65 and older. A Senior Care Options Plan is an organization made up of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, providers of long-term services and supports (LTSS), and other providers. It also has care coordinators to help you manage all your providers and services and supports. They all work together to provide the care you need.

<b>Will you get the same Medicare and MassHealth benefits in BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP) that you get now?</b>	<p>You will get your covered Medicare and MassHealth benefits directly from <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i>. You will work with a team of providers who will help determine what services will best meet your needs. This means that some of the services you get now may change. You may also get other benefits the same way you do now, directly from a State Agency like the Department of Mental Health or the Department of Developmental Services.</p> <p>When you enroll in <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i>, you and your care team will work together to develop an Individualized Plan of Care to address your health and support needs, reflecting your personal preferences and goals.</p> <p>If you are taking any Medicare Part D prescription drugs that <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> does not normally cover, you can get a temporary supply and we will help you to transition to another drug or get an exception for <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> to cover your drug if medically necessary. <p><b>What is prior authorization?</b></p>	<p>Prior authorization means an approval from <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> to seek services outside of our network or to get services not routinely covered by our network <b>before</b> you get the services. <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> may not cover the service, procedure, item, or drug if you don't get prior approval.</p> <p><b>If you need urgent or emergency care or out-of-area dialysis services, you don't need to get approval first.</b> <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> can provide you or your provider with a list of services or procedures that require you to get prior authorization from <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i> before the service is provided. If you have questions about whether prior authorization is required for specific services, procedures, items, or drugs, call Member Services for help.</p> <p>Please note that the plan covers emergency or urgent care services outside the United States or its territories but does NOT cover transportation to return you to the United States or its territories.</p>
<p><b>Do you pay a monthly amount (also called a premium) under <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i>?</b></p>	<p>No. Because you have MassHealth, you will not pay any monthly premiums, including your Medicare Part B premium, for your health coverage.</p>
<p><b>Do you pay a deductible as a member of <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i>?</b></p>	<p>No. You do not pay deductibles in <i>BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)</i>.</p>

## E. Your rights as a member of the plan

As a member of *BMC HealthNet Plan Senior Care Options (HMO D-SNP)*, you have certain rights. You can exercise these rights without being punished. You can also use these rights without losing your health care services. We will tell you about your rights at least once a year. - **You have a right to respect, fairness, and dignity.** This includes the right to:
  - Get covered services without concern about medical condition, health status, receipt of health services, claims experience, medical history, disability (including mental impairment), marital status, age, sex (including sex stereotypes and gender identity) sexual orientation, national origin, race, color, religion, creed or public assistance
  - Get information in other formats (for example, large print, braille, or audio) free of charge
  - Be free from any form of physical restraint or seclusion used as a means of coercion, discipline, convenience, or retaliation
- **You have the right to get information about your health care.** This includes information on treatment and your treatment options. This information should be in a format you can understand. This includes the right to get information on:
  - Description of the services we cover
  - How to get services
  - How much services will cost you (This plan is not subject to cost-sharing (\$0)).
  - Names of health care providers

- **You have a right to confidentiality and privacy.** This includes the right to:
  - Ask for and get a copy of your medical records in a way that you can understand and to ask for your records to be changed or corrected
  - Have your personal health information kept private
